

Environmental Policy For Trow Pool

We, the committee of BDAA, understand that the world's natural resources are finite and will eventually run out and therefore we must conserve them.

We also understand that we need to live in harmony with other species that share this fragile planet with us, therefore we support (S) or enforce (E) the following initiatives at Trow Pool:

- Use only barbless hooks (E).
- Carry out clean up's and ensure that rubbish is cleared and any spend line disposed of correctly (E).
- Liaise with the environment agency on any important issues (S).
- Protect the habitat of plants and animals as best we can (E).
- Encourage car sharing and cycling to Trow Pool to reduce CO₂ emissions (S).
- Do not allow camp fires (E).
- Trap American Cray Fish under approval from the Environment Agency (E).
- Carry out controlled clean up of the weed, but this is a real challenge (S)!
- Try to educate the younger anglers to appreciate the challenges ahead (S).
- Monitor fish care such as the correct use of landing net, disgorger and/or forceps and always make sure that fish are put back into the water as soon as possible (E).
- Examine any carp that are caught on rod and line and take a photograph to log them. And, if necessary, apply a healing solution to any damaged carp that are brought to our attention (S).
