Now for an update on fishing tactics, news and some fishy stories...

Support your local club and buy your permit from us because...

The following baits are proving successful at Trow but the list is not exhaustive:

Dog pellets on surface, Lob worm, paste, sweetcorn, bread (surface and bottom) and luncheon meat.

Remember to always use a hook length of lesser strength than the main line (generally 10-12lb). And please barbless hooks only.
